

Follow the timeline and checklist below to apply and enroll in a Catholic high school in the Archdiocese of Chicago.

2019/2020 CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL TIMELINE AND CHECKLIST

Septem	ber – November of 8th Grade
	Attend open houses at all of the Catholic high schools you may be interested in.
	Share your contact information at on-site school elementary visits or high school fairs.
	Speak with your parents about what kind of high school may be right for you (large, small, co-ed, single gender).
	Attend shadow days, sporting events and fine arts performances at the high schools you are interested in.
	Take entrance exam prep classes if offered at your elementary school.
	Contact the high school where you plan on taking the entrance exam to discuss special testing accommodations, if needed.
	Register for the entrance exam at only your first choice high school (beginning on November 22, 2019). See the school's website for registration information.
	Begin to explore financial aid opportunities and/or scholarships offered by the high school or outside organizations.
Decem	nber of 8th Grade
	Take the entrance exam (HSPT - High School Placement Test) on Saturday, December 7, 2019 at 8 a.m. at your first choice high school.
	If you have not already paid online when registering, bring \$25 and two Number 2 pencils on the day of the exam
	Submit release of records forms to your elementary school immediately following the exam.
	Contact the first choice school to register for a make-up date if you did not take the entrance exam on Dec. 7 at an Archdiocesan Catholic high school. <i>Note:</i> Students who tested at an Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic high school are not eligible to take the make-up at any other Archdiocesan high school.
	Complete the financial aid application according to the guidelines and deadlines established by the high school.
Janua	ry – March of 8th Grade
	Follow the application process for the school at which you tested.
	Be aware of the date of acceptance letters will be sent as indicated by the school at which you tested.
	Communicate any questions you may have with the admissions office or school administration.
	Be attentive to the registration process for the high school at which you were accepted.
	Register at the high school at which you were accepted.
March -	- May of 7th Grade
	Look for opportunities to attend 7th grade shadow days at the high schools you are interested in.
	Attend open houses at all of the Catholic high schools you may be interested in.
	Register for and attend any special athletic clinics/competitions, academic/fine arts opportunities that the Catholic high schools provide.
	Check out the Archdiocesan website to find the location of Catholic high schools in your area and also access links to the high schools' individual websites.
June –	August of Incoming 8th Grade
	Attend summer athletic, academic and fine arts camps.
	Checkout the various school websites to find out more information about curriculum, programs, clubs and extracurricular opportunities.
	Speak with current students or alumni about their experience at the school.
	Contact the high school for an individual school tour
